Whereas, the **First Responder Network Authority**—established by the U.S. Congress in 2012 under the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act—created FirstNet to provide a dedicated nationwide broadband network for public safety agencies and first responders; and

Whereas, **FirstNet** enhances communication, coordination, and efficiency during emergencies, offering secure, prioritized, and resilient communications in incidents ranging from routine operations to large-scale disasters; and

Whereas, **FirstNet** has played a critical role in Oklahoma, supporting emergency responses during the 2018 western Oklahoma wildfires, the 2019 EF-3 tornado in El Reno, and the 2020 statewide ice storm, ensuring first responders had uninterrupted communication to save lives and protect communities; and


